

Youth Innovation Grants

Cycle 5 Updates

The following changes are being implemented in cycle 5:

Project Timelines	Applicants can select a 6 or 9 month timeline for their project, 3 and 12 month project timelines are no longer available.
Project Titles	Applicants will be required to provide a project title when they apply for the Innovation Grant.
Final Report Due Date	Final reports are now due 30 days after the project has concluded
Final Report Narrative	The narrative section of the final report can be submitted in the following formats: • Written report • Video/ video blog • Adobe Sparks webpage More information and examples will be shared.
Grantee Support	Upon receiving funding, all youth grantees will be provided with a newly developed one-page checklist to review with their Special Olympics Project staff. The one-pager will help facilitate clear expectations of requirements and timelines, and will be a great opportunity to connect with the Program staff. The one-pagers will be distributed from SOIHQ to Regional staff prior to cycle 5 grantee announcement.
Post-Project Implementation	A closed Facebook group will be created as a network for Youth Leaders, SO staff and adult mentors continue sharing ideas and connecting post-project implementation. Upon submitting a final report, grantees will receive a link to join the group.
